Philip Bradley (Area Countryside Officer) has agreed with the landowner to carry out improvements on Carham Footpaths Nos 3 and 26 and councillors were impressed with the new bridge over the Tree Burn. The Chair commended Mr Bradley and his field team for an excellent job.

- The **Minutes** of the Meeting on 13 November 2018 were approved as read and signed.
- Matters Arising: The Clerk contacted the Berwick Area Office about the grit bin and mounds but no response to date. However, there are two new mounds of grit at East Learmouth (War Memorial). The Clerk will contact NCC again about the missing finger posts in Wark. The Clerk checked all the numbers of the street lights in Wark and the only one incorrectly sited on NCC's map is 15CC. Cllr Jobson raised the question about getting a bottle bank for Wark. He will prepare a survey, to be approved by councillors, to find out residents' views e.g. Is there a need for it and where would it be sited? Councillors pointed out there would need to be three for different coloured glass and if sited at the car park this would reduce parking spaces.
