- **Defibrillator Project:** Grants have been received from NCC's Community Chest (£1,750) and The Joicey Trust (£1,000). A committee meeting will be held on Monday 23 September to discuss applications received for Public Access Defibrillators in the parish. Councillors agreed that the phone boxes in Wark and Carham could be used to house the defibrillators in those communities.
- **Draft Rights of Way Improvement Plan Consultation:** NCC's vision is for a well-managed, accessible, safe and interconnected network of PROWs for all users. Cllr. Poland will submit comments on behalf of Carham Parish Council by 18 October, particularly with regard to Policy 5, and put information on the Carham Community Website.
 - Review of the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way: Any additional facts or evidence to be submitted for NCC to consider by 30 November. Applications have previously been made to modify Carham Footpath 37 and Carham Restricted Byway No 38. These will be considered by NCC during 2025. Carham Parish Council has no further evidence.
